Widely regarded as a creative genius and one

of the best attacking players of all time, Tal played in a daring, combinatorial style. His play was known above all for improvisation and unpredictability. Every game, he once said, was as inimitable and invaluable as a poem. He was often called "Misha", a diminutive for Mikhail, and "The magician from Riga". In addition, Tal was a highly regarded chess writer. He also holds the records for both the first and second longest unbeaten streaks in competitive chess history.

Event Details – Individual

Bangalore's most popular Chess promoting School, Silicon City Academy of Secondary Education, will host the Mikhail Tal Memorial Chess Tournament (51st Edition of ICA Events) on July 1, 2018 at its premises. The Event will be organized by Innovators Chess Academy.

The Tournament will be conducted in the Open, Under 7, U9, U11 and U16 Categories.

Entry Fee to Open Category is Rs 750 for UKCA players and Rs 800 for non UKCA players. Entry fee for the Age Categories is Rs 550 for UKCA players and Rs 600 for non UKCA players. Players can take part in both, Open and Age Category. Time given will be 15 minutes + 5 seconds increment.

Last Date for sending entries is June 29, 2018. Any entries sent post this date can be accepted at the discretion of the Organizers only.

All age Categories will have 5 Trophies for Boys and 5 Trophies for Girls. In case we receive 100 or more entries in any age Category, then we will be giving away a total of 10 Trophies for Boys and Girls respectively. A player will forfeit the prize if he/she is absent from the Prize Distribution.

Strictly, no refunds or carry forward of entry fees is allowed.

Event Details – Team

The Team Event will be conducted from 3 pm onwards and will conclude by 6.30 pm. The age categories will be Under 8, 10 and 13 respectively.

Cut off date for Under 8 = Born in 2010 or later.

Cut off date for Under 10 = Born in 2008 or later.

Cut off date for Under 13 = Born in 2005 or later.

Each Team will consist of four players (Playing on Board A, B, C and D respectively). The Team should have a name of its own.

The top three Teams will be awarded a Trophy each. If we receive at least 5 Girls Teams, then we will have 3 Exclusive Trophies (plus Board Prizes) for the top 3 Girls Teams.

Medals (Gold, Silver and Bronze) will be awarded for the top 3 players in Board A, B, C and respectively.

Entry fee is Rs 1,400 per Team.

Open Category details (start time 3 pm):

The Open Category will be divided into groups of 32 Players each. Each group will have a prize fund of Rs 20,000/-. The division will be based on the rating of the players. The highest rated players will be slotted into Group A. If Group B (or the last group) has 20 or lesser players, then there will be a total of 5 prizes awarded.
