Certificates should preferably be from the Panchayat, Municipality Or Corporation.

AICF Registration: The participants are informed that AICF Players registration is mandatory for Open rated Championship and it should be done well before participating in this Championship only through online. System of Play: The championship shall be played under the FIDE Laws of Chess for a total of 9-rounds on a Swiss-League basis. Latest FIDE (2018) rules will be applicable.

Time-Control: Each player shall have 60 minutes with an addition of 30 seconds per move starting from move one.

Default Time: Default time for arriving to the chessboard is 15 minutes.

- 1) Direct encounter
- 2) Buchholz Cut 1
- 3) Buchholz
- 4) Sonneborn Berger
- 5) The greater number of wins (forfeit included) cash prizes will not be shared.

Protests: Protest if any, against the decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be made in writing with a protest fee of Rs.1000/- within 15 minutes of the occurrence of the incident, with a fee of Rupees 1,000/- which will be refunded if the protest is upheld by the appeals committee.

-: Appeals Committee Members:-

Appeals Committee: A five member appeals committee shall be formed by the organizers. All the members and reserves shall be from different districts. No member of the Committee can vote on a dispute in which a player from his own district is involved and in such case(s) the reserves member(s) shall take his place in the committee.

Interpretation: For interpretation of the rule(s) and deciding any point not covered by the above rules of the tournament, the decision of the Tournament Committee shall be final and binding on all. The Tournament Committee has every right to make any addition or amendment to these rules, without prior notice. Such changes will, however, be displayed in the tournament hall.

PIO (Person of Indian origin) / OCI (Overseas Citizen of India) card holders

As per Government of India guidelines / rules, players with PIO / OCI documents cannot play for India. As a result, AICF had taken a decision that these players cannot participate in any selection tournaments like district selection / State selection and National Championship which ultimately lead to the selection of the Indian National team. However these players can play in all FIDE rated events and other tournaments in India and abroad.
