Raghunandan KS Champion

Fide Master Raghunandan KS of Bangalore clinched the championship in style by defeating Gavi Siddayya of Bangalore in the final round of Karnataka State Open FIDE Rating Chess Championship 2016 which concluded today at Silicon City Academy of Secondary Education, Kumar Nursaery, New Bank Colony, Off Kanakapura Road, Bangalore. The championship is organised by Innovators chess Academy under the auspices of United Karnataka Chess Association.

A fifteen year boy, Raghunandan KS created a history by becoming the youngest champion of Karnataka Open Chess Championship. Fide Master Girish Koushik was the youngest champion till date.

Vinayak Kulkarni and Raghunandan had scored eight and points each in ten rounds, based on better tie break score Raghunandan was emerged as champion. Vinayak Kulkarni became the first runner up.

Raghunandan KS, Vinayak Kulkarni, Likhith Chilukuri and former State Champion N Sanjay will represent Karnataka State for the upcoming National Challenger chess Championship 2016 to be held at Uttar Pradesh from 9-19 July, 2016.
