01. Swiss System will be followed
02. Time Control: 10 Minutes (Straight Finish)
03. No of Rounds – 06 or 07 depends on the number of number of participants.
04. First Round will start sharp @ 06 PM on 23rd July 2022.
05. Tie-break: Buchholz tiebreak system will be applied. In case of tie, the prizes will not be shared.
06. Proper Internet Connection either wire or WIFI with good speed is players responsibility.
07. Chief Arbiter has the right to ask the players to produce birth certificate, if necessary.
08. Chief Arbiter's decision will be final and binding on all players concerned.
09. Chess.com link will be sent to registered mail id on 22nd of July 2022. The players should login before 08 PM on 22nd of July 2022.
10. Prize Winners will be announced after 03 days of completion of the tournament after checking the fair play violations.

## **Chess.com Fair Play Policy**

Chess.com has a responsibility to maintain a clean, fair platform for chess players around the world. We reserve the right to monitor all chess games played on our platform.

- All of your moves must be your own
- Do not cheat in any way
- Do not get help from any other person, including parents, friends, coaches or another player
- Do not use chess engines, software of any kind, bots, plugins or any tools that analyse positions during play
- Do not use table-bases or any other resources that show the best move (in both Online and Daily chess)
- You may use Opening Explorer or other books without engine evaluations in Daily chess only (not in Online / Live play)
- Do not perform any automated analysis or "blunder checking" of your games in progress
- Do not allow anyone else to use your account
- Do not use anyone else's account
- Do not artificially manipulate ratings, matches, or game outcomes
- Do not interfere with the gameplay of other members
- Suspecting your opponent of using outside help is not an excuse to do the same. If you suspect someone is cheating, report the player to Chess.com.
