



# KARNATAKA STATE CHESS ASSOCIATION(KSCA)

## FINANCIAL REGULATIONS

The revenue of the KSCA will Include

### 1. Annual Affiliation Fee

Each affiliated District association shall pay to the KSCA Rs./- (Rs. Two Thousand Only) and for Academies Rs.2500/-between 1<sup>st</sup> & 15<sup>th</sup> of April or with a fine of Rs.500/- before 30<sup>th</sup> April of that year.

### 2. Arbiters Registration Fee

Annual Affiliation Fee of Rs.500 to be paid for officiating in KSCA tournaments.

### 3. Recognition Fee for State / District / Corporate Tournaments

### 4. Entry Fee Regulation for various Tournaments.

The Organizers of various tournaments/championships shall charge entry fee from players as per the below table.

1. Rating Tournaments - As per AICF/FIDE specification
2. Open one day Tournaments - Rs.700
3. Interschool Tournaments - Rs.500
4. State Level Rating Tournaments – 1% of Prize Money or Rs.2500 whichever is lower.

#### 5. Arbiters Remuneration:

The Chief Arbitrator shall be reimbursed travelling expenses of 2AC train fare, free boarding and lodging apart from local transportation to the venue. **A lump sum of Rs 2000 shall be paid per event for pre and post process work.**

The Deputy Chief / Arbiters shall be reimbursed travelling expenses of 2AC train fare, free boarding and lodging apart from local transportation to the venue.

Note: Any other events organizer shall fix the remuneration directly with the Arbiters.

## **6. Player's Participation in National Championship (Effective from April 2020)**

- (i) Each Selected Player who has been representing in the National Championship shall be paid Rs.2500/- as conveyance charges.
- (ii) The player shall be eligible and can apply for Concessional 3AC Class Train from home town to Championship and back.
- (iii) The normal entry fee for the National Championship shall be borne by the organizer of the state championship.
- (iv) Dress Code: Minimum 2 T-Shirts each (with the Association name) shall be supplied to all the players who are representing the state. For the normal entry the Association shall bear the cost and Special entry the the cost of the T-shirts shall be collected from the concerned player.
