Financial Regulations

1. Affiliation Fees:

- Each affiliated District Chess Association in Karnataka shall pay Rs. 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) and affiliated Chess Academies in Karnataka shall pay Rs. 2500/- (Rupees Two Thousand Five Hundred Only) on every financial year before 1st to 15th April. There after an Rs. 500/- (Five Hundred only) is levied as late fees till 30th April.

2. Arbiters Registration Fees:

- Annual affiliation fees of Rs. 500/- (Rupees Five Hundred Only) to be paid for officiating in KSCA chess tournaments)

3. Recognition fees for State / District / Corporate Chess Tournaments:

4. Entry Fees Regulation for other various Chess Tournaments:

- The Organizers of various Chess Tournaments / Chess Championships shall charge entry fees to players as per below guidelines:
 - Rating Tournaments – As per AICF / FIDE specifications
 - One Day Open Tournaments – Rs. 700/-
 - Inter-School Chess Tournaments – Rs. 500/-
 - State Level Rating Chess Tournaments – 1% of Prize Money or Rs. 2500/- whichever is lower.
 - Karnataka State Chess Championships – Refer Below table

5. Remuneration for Arbiters:

- The Chief Arbiters shall be reimbursed with travelling expenses of 2nd AC Train fare, free lodging and boarding, and local transportation to the venue.
- A lump sum of Rs. 2000/- (Rupees Two Thousand only) shall be paid for pre and post tournament process work.
- The Deputy Chief Arbiter shall be reimbursed with travelling expenses of 2nd AC Train fare, free lodging and boarding, and local transportation to the venue.
- Below table indicates on remuneration to arbiters / deputy arbiters (Per day):

- For any other monthly open rapid, inter-school, corporate events – organizer and arbiters can fix the remunerations.

5. Karnataka Players participating in National Chess Championships (Effective from April 2020)

- Each selected player who will represent Karnataka in National Chess Championships shall be paid Rs. 2500/- (Rupees Two Thousand Five Hundred only) towards conveyance charges.
- The players shall be eligible and can apply for Concessional 3-Tier AC Train from Home Town to Championship and back.
- The normal entry fees for the National Championship shall be borne by the Organizer of the respective State Chess Championships.
- Dress Code: Minimum 2 T-Shirts each (with KSCA Name) shall be provided to all the players who are representing Karnataka State in Nationals. For the normal entry, the Association shall bear the cost of T-Shirts and cost will be applicable for special entry players.

6. As per KSCA guidelines, a minimum distance of 300 KM is fixed to organize any Rating tournaments in Karnataka. However, there is no restriction for local tournaments to be organized in particular city.
7. KSCA will provide Chess sets and Chess clocks for the Open Classical FIDE rating and State Championship free of cost. The organizer has to collect it from KSCA office and return it immediately after the event.
8. KSCA will be awarding Rs 20000 (Rupees Twenty Thousand only) to the Winners of Asian and World Gold medal winners, Rs 15000 (Rupees Fifteen Thousand only) for Silver Medal Winners and Rs 10000 (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) for Bronze Medal Winners.
9. KSCA will be awarding Rs 10000 (Rupees Ten Thousand Only) to the top 3 Medal Winners of National Chess Championship.
10. KSCA will be awarding Rs. 1,00,000 (Rupees One Lakh only) for players getting GM title in Karnataka and Rs. 25,000 (Rupees Twenty Five Thousand only) for players getting IM title in Karnataka
