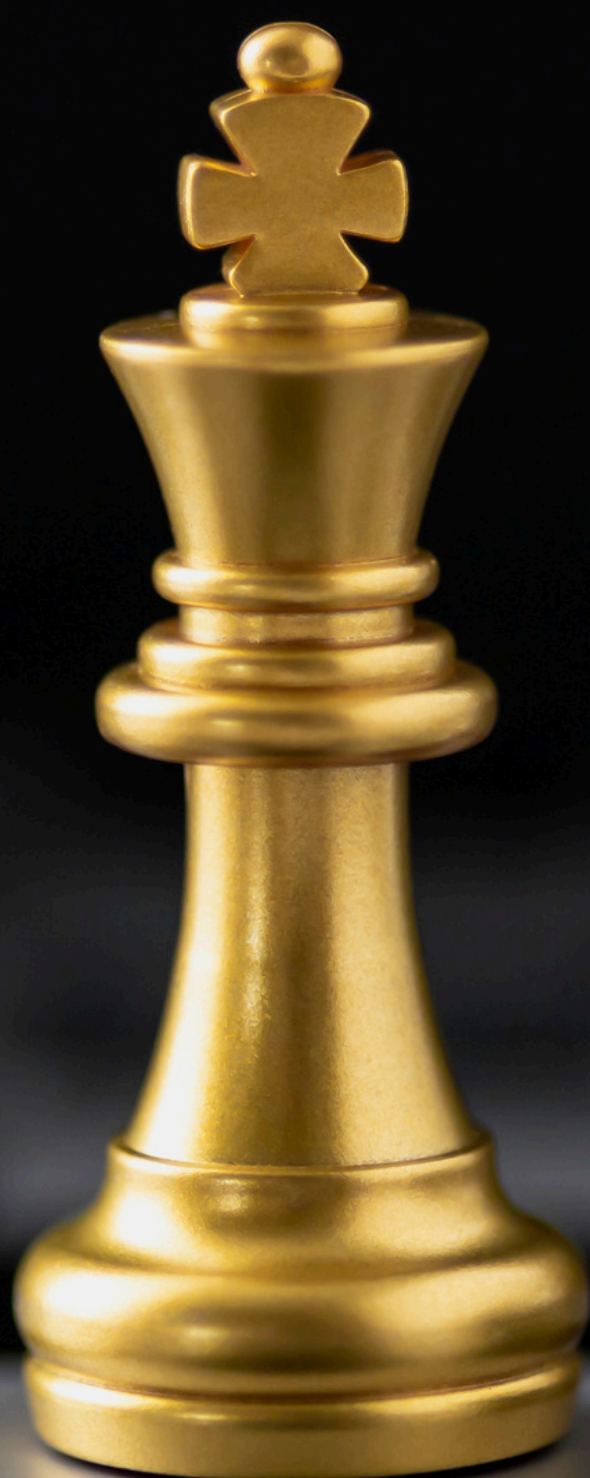

### Rules and Regulations

- This is a selection tournament for the state under 11 and under 19 championship 2026
- KSCA registration is compulsory.
- Bangalore Urban players who are Indian Nationals are eligible to participate.
- Players born on or after 01.01.2015 are eligible to participate in under 11.
- Players born on or after 01.01.2007 are eligible to participate in under 19.
- Birth certificate should be produced to the arbiter if required.
- Top 2 boys and 2 girls will represent Bangalore Urban district in the upcoming Karnataka state under 11 and under 19 championship 2026.
- No of rounds will depend on the number of entries received.
- Time format 30 minutes + 30 sec increment from move 1.
- No spot entries.
- No refund/transfer of entry fees in case of withdrawal or no show.
- Players and parents have to make their own arrangement for food.
- Water will be provided. Please get your own water bottles.
- Chess sets and clocks will be provided to all participants.
- No electronic items are allowed inside the playing hall (including wrist watches)
- E-certificate will be given to all participants.

#### NOTE:

- Players are eligible to participate only in their respective age categories.
- A player who participates in under 11 category will be eligible to participate in the under 19 category state championship.
