Rules & Information: -

1. Every participant must wear the School Uniform and school ID card.
2. All decisions taken by the organisers will be final and binding on all the participating schools. The Organising Committee reserves the right to alter or amend any of these Rules.
3. The teachers/coaches are requested to kindly maintain the discipline of the students. Any misbehaviour may lead to disqualification. Any damage to the property will be reimbursed by the participating school.
4. A Competitor MUST participate in one age group only (Not necessarily his/her Age- Group).
5. A properly filled Entry Form, along with photocopies of Aadhar and School ID cards and the complete team list, must be submitted to the Organising Committee before the first game.
6. Competitors must report along with the Teacher 30 minutes before the commencement of their game to the Hon. Chief Arbiter. This will apply to first-round matches.
7. All games will be played under the Swiss League System. The number of rounds will depend on the number of competitors in each group, i.e., 7 or more. Each Competitor must play all the rounds under this system irrespective of win, lose or draw. Each Competitor will get 1 point for a win, ½ point for a draw and 0 points for defeat.
8. The Competitor who leads on points after the prescribed number of rounds will be declared the Winner.
9. In case of tie (equal points). Tie break System will be Used.
11. If a Competitor remains absent for two consecutive rounds without prior permission from the Chief Arbiter, his/her name will be struck off from future rounds. A walk-over will be treated as per the instructions of the Chief Arbiter.
12. The Organising Committee, along with the Chief Arbiter, will be the final authority regarding walk-over, which cannot be claimed by any competitor as a matter of right.
13. The decision of the Tournament Committee on all matters connected with the tournament will be final and binding.
14. **Protest:** Any protest, if at all lodged, must be done through the accredited Sports-in-Charge/Teacher-in-Charge/Coach of the team within 15 minutes of the conclusion of the match, along with the protest Fee of ₹ 1,500/-.

Prizes: Merit Certificates and Medals will be awarded to the first 4 positions and Trophies to the first 3 (three) positions for Boys and Girls.
