Rules and Regulations

- This is a selection tournament for the state under 09, under 13 and under 17 championship 2026
- KSCA registration is compulsory.
- Bengaluru Urban players who are Indian Nationals are eligible to participate.
- Birth certificate should be produced to the arbiter if required.
- Top 2 boys and 2 girls will represent Bangalore Urban district in the upcoming Karnataka state under 09, under 13 and under 17 championship 2026.
- No of rounds will depend on the number of entries received. Schedule will be decided in the players meeting.
- Time format 30 minutes + 30 sec increment from move 1.
- Rounds will be played on both days.
- No spot entries.
- No refund/transfer of entry fees in case of withdrawal or no show.
- Players and parents have to make their own arrangement for food.
- Water will be provided. Please get your own water bottles.
- Chess sets and clocks will be provided to all participants.
- No electronic items are allowed inside the playing hall (including wrist watches)
- E-certificate will be given to all participants.

NOTE:

- Eligibility for the state championship requires participation in at least 75% of the total rounds.
- Players are eligible to participate only in their respective age categories.
- A player who participates in under 09 category will be eligible to participate in the under 13 and under 17 category state championships.
- A player who participates in under 13 category will be eligible to participate in the under 17 category state championship.
