Entry fee structure:

Entries received until March 10, 2026: Rs 2250/-

Entries received from March 11 2026 until April 15 2026: Rs 3000/-

Entries received from April 16 to April 28 2026: Rs 4000/-

Entry fees is non-refundable and non-transferrable. Free entry to all Grandmasters and International Masters. They will have to take care of their accommodation on their own.

Venue and Metro accessibility; Do's and Don'ts from the Mall Management:

The Prestige Centre for Performing Arts is conveniently located adjacent to Konanakunte Metro Station.

Parking charges are ₹80 for cars and ₹30 for two-wheelers for the first hour. Thereafter, an additional ₹20 per hour for cars and ₹10 per hour for two-wheelers will apply.

Do's and Don'ts

- Parents are not permitted to sleep inside the mall or PCPA premises.
- Please ensure parents are briefed clearly about the mall and PCPA decorum.
- Parents are welcome to drop their children off at PCPA and spend time at the mall food court during the event.
- Parents are not allowed to sit and work in the PCPA common areas
- Please keep the mall or PCPA area clean and neat.
- Promotional stalls are not allowed in the mall premises.
- Your participation in the event shall be deemed as acceptance of the above guidelines. We request the cooperation of all parents and participants in maintaining decorum and ensuring the smooth conduct of the championship.

Rules and Regulations

- 1) All players of Karnataka with a valid AICF ID for the current financial year 2026-27 are eligible to participate, regardless whether they are rated or unrated. To register/renew your AICF Membership, please refer the link: <https://prs.aicf.in/players>. PIO/OCI Passport holders are not eligible to participate. This Event is for residents of Karnataka only.
- 2) All players must provide their valid KSCA ID at the time of registration. To register/renew your KSCA membership for the financial year 2026-27, please refer the link below

- 3) Tie break for the Event will be announced and explained in the Players Meeting. The same will be published on the Notice Board during the Tournament.
- 4) Default time (Walkover time): The default time will be 15 minutes.
- 5) A five-member Appeals Committee shall be formed during the Players Meeting.
- 6) Any protest against a decision of the Chief Arbiter shall be submitted in writing within 10 minutes of the incident, accompanied by a protest fee of ₹1,000/-. The fee will be refunded if the appeal is upheld. The decision of the Appeals Committee shall be final and binding on all participants.
- 7) Participation Certificate: E-Certificates will be provided to all participants. The same will be uploaded within 15 days from the conclusion of the Event on icachess.in.
- 8) Possession of any electronic device, including wristwatches, during play is strictly prohibited. Violation may result in forfeiture of the game.
- 9) The Tournament will be conducted as per FIDE Laws of Chess – FIDE Swiss System of 9 Rounds.
- 10) FIDE IDs will be generated during the Event – this is for players who do not have a FIDE ID.
- 11) Parents and non-participants are not allowed inside the Tournament Hall during play.
- 12) Prize Money will be transferred online within two weeks from the date of completion of the Event.
- 13) Time Control - 60 Minutes each with 30 seconds increment from move number one.

14) All prize winners are required to be present at the Prize Distribution Ceremony. The Organiser reserves the right to impose a penalty of ₹2,000 in the event of absence without prior approval. Participants are therefore advised to plan their return travel accordingly.
