4. Tie break: Buchholz tiebreak system will be applied. In case of tie prizes will not be shared.
5. Proper internet connection either wired or WIFI with good speed is Players responsibility
6. Age proof certificate is a must for the players to claim their prizes.
7. Chief Arbiter has the rights to ask the players to produce the birth certificate if necessary.
8. Chief Arbiter's decision shall be final and binding on all players concerned.
9. No refund or No carry forward of entry fee. E-certificate will be given to all. Please provide correct email ID's.
10. Chess.com link will be sent on OR before 06-06-2026 to the Players. Player's should login before 10.00pm on 06-06-2026.

Do not artificially manipulate ratings, matches, or game outcomes

Do not interfere with the game play of other members

Suspecting your opponent of using outside help is not an excuse to do the same. If you suspect someone is cheating, report the player to Chess.com.
